The Journal of Higher Education Outreach and Engagement is the premier peer-reviewed, interdisciplinary journal to advance theory and practice related to all forms of outreach and engagement between higher education institutions and communities. This includes highlighting innovative endeavors; critically examining emerging issues, trends, challenges, and opportunities; and reporting on studies of impact in the areas of public service, outreach, engagement, extension, engaged research, community-based research, community-based participatory research, action research, public scholarship, service-learning, and community service.

The *JHEOE* invites manuscripts that are either research articles, reflective essays, projects with promise, practice stories from the field, book reviews, and dissertation overviews related to the five themes of the 2011 National Outreach Scholarship Conference:

- Methods and Practices of Community-Based Research and Creative Activities
- Translational Science and the Diffusion of Innovation
- Globalization and International Engagement
- Technologies as Tools for Engagement
- Leadership and Professional Development for Engaged Scholarship

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GENERAL GUIDELINES FOR ALL SUBMISSIONS

Manuscripts should

- represent original, unpublished work not under consideration by other publications;
- indicate that Internal Review Board (IRB) human subjects approval was secured (or explain why it was not required);
- not be more than 10,000 words;
- have the names, institutional affiliations, addresses, phone numbers, and e-mail addresses of all authors masked throughout to ensure anonymity in the reviewing process; and have a separate cover page that includes all of this information as a supplementary file;
- include a 100-word abstract;
- be typed, double-spaced and formatted using American Psychological Association (APA) style, 6th edition;
- be formatted and saved in Microsoft Word; and
- be copy edited prior to submission.

A Manuscript is evaluated according to

- the appropriateness or fit for the *Journal's* mission;
- its significance in contributing new knowledge (advancing a field of study); or providing best practices and lessons-learned;
- the rigor and appropriateness of the scholarship;
- its readability and flow.

Additional criteria are based on the type of submission: research article, reflective essay, project with promise, practice story from the field, book review, or dissertation overview.

The *Journal of Higher Education Outreach and Engagement* was founded in 1996 at the University of Georgia (UGA). Today, the *Journal* is supported by UGA's Office of the Vice President for Public Service and Outreach.

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
